## Report

### Institution Innovation Council (IIC)

In 2018, the Ministry of Education (MoE) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) launched the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) program for Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). In this regard, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose College established its Institute's Innovation Council on 30 September 2021, during IIC 4.0, and established a committee to accomplish its goals. The goal is to foster an environment that is conducive to thought and encouraging of enterprise and entrepreneurship. As a government institution for girls with students from rural and semi-urban areas and faculties in the arts, commerce, and sciences, it is desirable to educate them about ventures and provide an environment that encourages entrepreneurship. Quarterly objectives and activities are planned and carried out in accordance with the IIC Club. The IIC Club has completed all IIC-driven, MIC-driven, Celebration-driven, and Self-driven activities in its first session (IIC 4.0) in pursuance of its goals. IIC Club has participated in 25 activities during the IIC 4.0 session, of which 12 were IIC-driven, 3 were MIC-driven, 8 were celebration activities, and 3 were self-driven.



During the first session (IIC 4.0), the Institute participated in the Mentor-Mentee Plan and Impact Lecture Scheme, and received sanction for the Impact Lecture initiative. In

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In addition, the institute has three Innovation Ambassadors with advanced training. The Ministry of Education's Innovation Council (MIC) awarded this session's institution a score of two stars. Under the dynamic leadership of Principal Professor Anuradha Tiwari, the Innovation Council is committed to establishing a culture and environment of idea generation, startup, and entrepreneurship. In accordance with this objective, the IIC Club has conducted 35 activities during the Second session (IIC 5.0), of which 21 were IIC-driven, 3 were MIC-driven, 8 were celebration activities, and 3 were self-driven. Continuously, College will also participate in the Third Session (IIC 6.0) in 2023-24.
