BEST PRACTICE 1:

INSTITUTION'S INNOVATION COUNCIL (IIC)

Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Government Girls PG College, Aliganj, Lucknow established its Institute's Innovation Council during IIC 4.0 on 30 September 2021 and formed a committee to meet its goals. The Innovation Council under the dynamic leadership of Principal Prof. Anuradha Tiwari is dedicated to establish a culture and environment of idea generation, startup and entrepreneurship.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PRACTICE

- 1. The goal is to create an environment that is conducive to thinking and inspiring for startups and entrepreneurship.
- 2. Being a government girls college with students from rural and semi urban areas with arts, commerce and science faculties, it is desirable to make them aware about startups and give them such an environment.

CONTEXT:

In the Year 2018, the Ministry of Education (MoE) through MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC) launched the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) program in Collaboration with AICTE for Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). In this regard Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose College established its Institute's Innovation Council during IIC 4.0 on 30 September 2021 and formed a committee to meet its goals.

THE PRACTICE:

Under IIC Club every quarter the targets and activities are set with proper planning and executed accordingly. In pursuit of its goals, the IIC Club in its first session has completed all activities consisting of IIC driven, MIC driven, Celebration and Self driven activities. In this regard, IIC Club has undertaken 25 activities, out of which 12 are IIC driven, 3 MIC driven, 8 celebration activities and 3 self driven activities.

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS

During the first session, the Institute participated in the Mentor-mentee Plan, and Impact Lecture Scheme and obtained approval for Impact Lecture. There are also 3 Innovation Ambassadors in institute with advanced level of training.

PROBLEM ENCOUNTERED AND RESOURCE REQUIRED

The limited resources of the College, the rural background of the students and lack of technical support bring the problems before IIC.

The establishment of IIC in the College is a historic step to recognize it as academically growing institute and carries many opportunity for innovation, start up and IPR both for the faculty and students.

BEST PRACTICE 2:

PRATIBHA SAMMAN (FELICITATION PROGRAMME)

A Pratibha Samman ceremony was organized on 11 May, 2022 at the local Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Government Women's Post Graduate College, Aliganj to felicitate the students for academically and curricularly doing good.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PRACTICE

- 1. To motivate the students for their academic performance.
- 2. To promote the capacity building in them in cultural activities.
- 3. To provide them a common plateform for their learning and exposition.
- 4. To develop the habit of peer group knowledge sharing.
- 5. To inculcate the nature among the students being curious and aware to the information.
- 6. To motivate students to learn through experience and motivation.
- 7. To highlight the habit team work, leadership and dedication.
- 8. To provide happy ambiance among the students in the times of pandemic.

THE CONTEXT

THE PRACTICE

During the Pratibha Samman ceremony twenty-five girl students, who have displayed their excellent talent in different fields, apart from the girl students who got the highest marks in different classes, were felicitated by the chief guest Hon'ble Shri Yogendra Upadhyay, Cabinet Minister, Department of Higher Education. On this occasion, MLA from Lucknow North Dr. Neeraj Bora was also present as a special guest. Welcoming all the guests, Principal Professor Anuradha Tiwari said that every year a Pratibha Samman Samaroh was being organized in the college, so that the girl students could get inspiration and they could come forward in different fields of life along with studies. The Principal said that in the past also the Governor of the State Mrs. Anandi Ben Patel, former Deputy Chief Minister Dr. Dinesh Sharma, present Deputy Chief Minister Mr. Brajesh Pathak etc. have been dignitaries in such functions. The program was inaugurated by the chief guest and other dignitaries by lighting the lamp and garlanding the idol of Saraswati. Addressing the girl students in a packed hall, he said that the government had been committed to safeguard the education of girl students and make them self-reliant.
