Apart from this, she was also the first woman Governor of India (Uttar Pradesh) in this way Sarojini Naidu has been a shining example of women empowerment and also said that we all should learn from her by taking inspiration from her and behaving like her. In addition to knowing power and putting their energy in positive works, the girl students told some of their personal problems and tried to solve them through counselling. About 57 UG&PG students from all the faculties were present in this lecture. This program was organized in Radha Kamal Mukherjee Room at New PG block.

Significance/need of the program:- Keeping in view the growing imbalance in the man-woman ratio, we have to

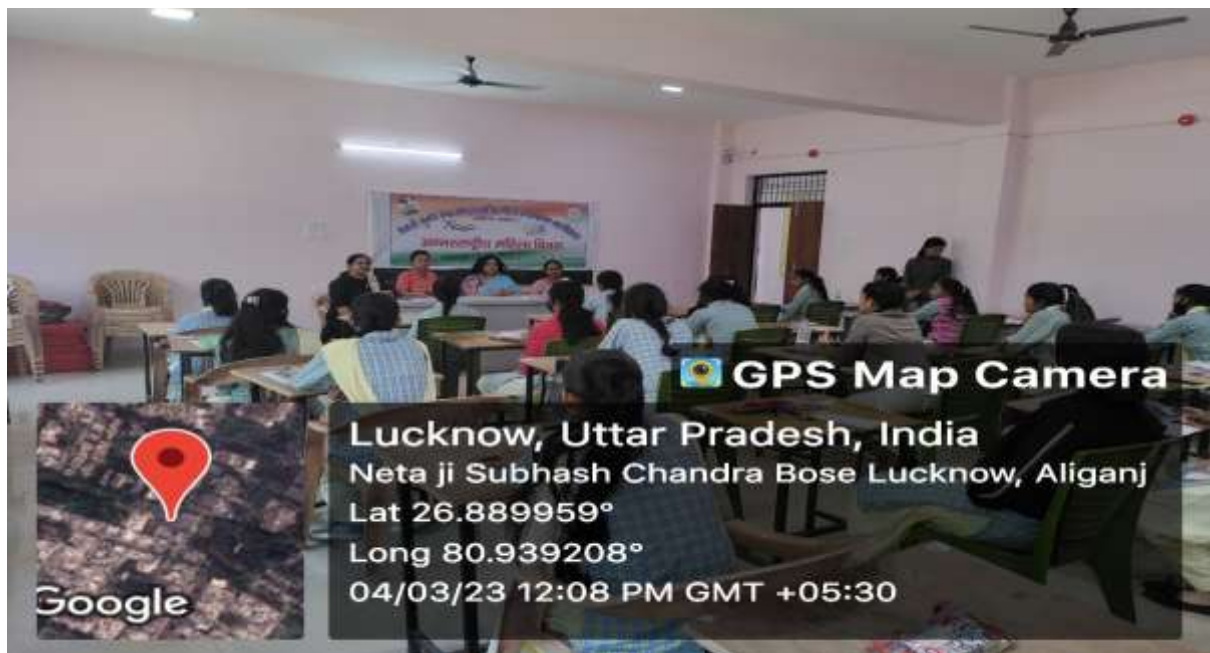

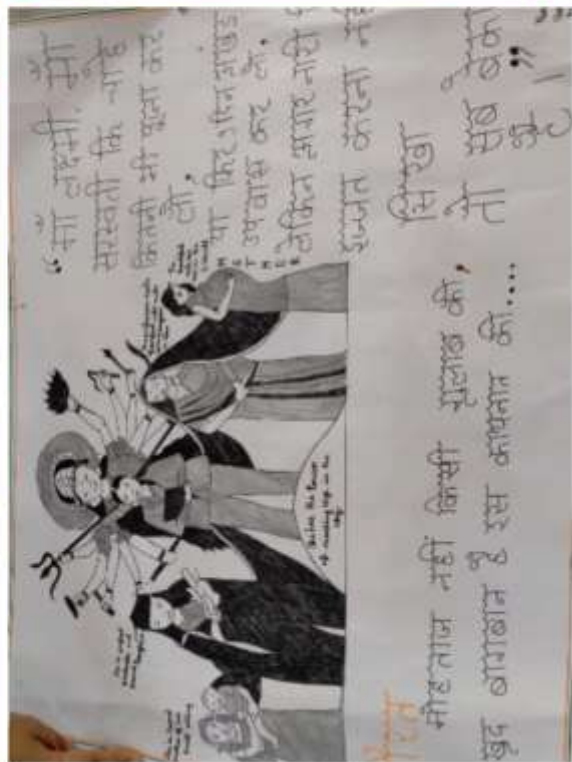
In this programme member of women cell Dr.Poonam verma ,Dr. Kranti singh, Dr.Pratima Bhardwaj and some faculty members were also presented

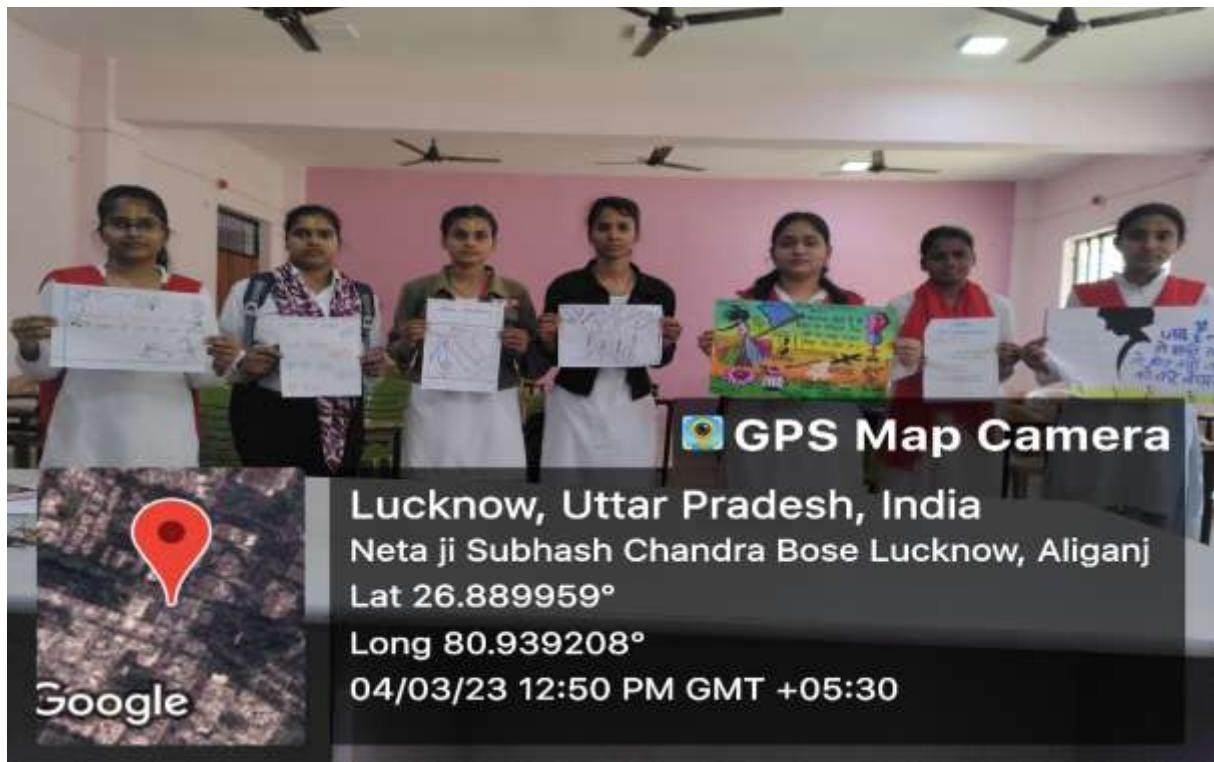
It was a lot of fun. At the end, prize distribution for the winners of essay writing competition was done.

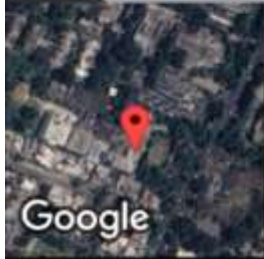
